

MHS Yearbook FAQ:

Did I pre-purchase a 2009-2010 yearbook? Check the 2009-2010 pre-purchased yearbooks link on the Maize High School home page; if your student's name is not listed, you can still purchase a yearbook through the end of MARCH (formerly February; our plant extended the deadline). Yearbooks are \$40; checks can be made out to MHS Yearbook. You can mail your check to Maize High School (attn: Anne Debes) or have your student drop it by Mrs. Debes's room, F22. Please include your student's name with your payment.

Is it too late to buy a senior ad? You can still buy a senior ad that will appear in the 2009-2010 yearbook; check the form for price/size information. A copy of the form is available on the MHS home page. Ads will be available until space is filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

When will yearbooks be available? We cover the entire school year, including end-of-the-year events like prom and graduation, in one bound yearbook. We send in our final deadline in early June; the book is ready for students to pick up in early August. Students who pre-purchased yearbooks and still attend MHS will receive their books during En-Cor, usually within the first week of school. Graduate yearbooks can be picked up in the MHS front office by the graduates themselves or by friends or family members. In order to keep costs down, we do not mail out all graduate books. If you move and no friends or family members are available to pick up your book, please contact Mrs. Debes with an address and your book will be mailed.
